

## **Welcome Back Golfers – Updated April 30, 2021**

As a golfer, it is your responsibility to read and understand this document.

- Golf is an approved outdoor, recreational activity by the Government of Saskatchewan.
- The health, safety and well-being of our staff and golfers remain our top priority.
- We believe that golfing safely can allow for exercise and mental health benefits.



### **Overview**

- The guidelines below are from the "Re-Open Saskatchewan" Plan, not the Maple Creek Golf Club.
- Players showing any signs of illness will not be permitted to play that day. If you feel/show any symptoms such as cough, headache, fever, shortness of breath, etc.

### **Booking Tee Times**

- All golfers are required to book a tee time in advance, by calling 306-662-2886.
  - Walk-ons may be permitted if tee times are available.
- Tee times will be available every 10 minutes to avoid congestion on the course.
- A maximum of 4 players per group – no exceptions at this time.
- All golfers must be on time and start on Hole #1. Please do not be late.
- You are allowed to let others play through as long as social distancing is maintained.

### **Arriving at the Golf Course**

- Please do not arrive more than 15 minutes before your scheduled tee time, unless you are using the driving range/practice green or having a beverage/snack under the "Sunde Pavilion".
- If you are arriving in your own power cart, please enter along the road outside the cart sheds.
  - You will not be able to enter by the cart storage garage or in front by the flower planters/bike racks.
- Enter the Pro Shop, with a mask on, one at a time to pay for your golf and other items.
- Before proceeding to Hole #1, please "check in" with the Pro Shop.

### **Retail & Merchandise Sales**

- Pro Shop sales must follow the "Clothing and Retail Guidelines" in the Re Open Saskatchewan document.

### **Pro Shop**

- **You must wear a mask when entering the Pro Shop – no exceptions.**
- Only one person is allowed in the Pro Shop at a time.
- There is a plexiglass barrier installed inside and a hand sanitizer dispenser outside the Pro Shop.

### **Washrooms**

- We will have 2 port-o-potties located near the Pro Shop.
- Indoor washrooms may be available to use, one person at a time.
- The other port-o-potties on the golf course will be open as well.

### **Rentals – Power Carts and Pull Carts**

- Power cart rentals will be \$10 per seat for 9 holes and \$15 per seat for 18 holes.
- Pull carts will be available, at no charge, for those who would like to walk.
- All carts will be disinfected/sanitized after each use.
- Please make sure you empty your rental power cart when you return to the Pro Shop.
- Please keep the golf carts on the cart paths or on the fairways, entering at 90 degrees.
  - Please stay out of the rough and other prohibited areas.

## Food & Beverage

- We will be selling alcoholic/non-alcoholic beverages and snacks in the Pro Shop.
- Domestic drinks will be \$5 each and Premium drinks will be \$6 each.
- “Drink Special” – 4 Domestic for \$18/4 Premium for \$22. (Excludes tournaments)
- We will not be providing cooler bags and ice. Please bring your own empty cooler and ice.
- **\*\* No Outside Alcohol is Permitted \*\***

## On the Course

- The flag sticks must remain in place. There will be a foam pool noodle on the end of each flag stick to prevent the ball from going into the bottom of the cup. **PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE THE FLAG STICKS!**
- Sand trap rakes, divot boxes on Par 3s and ball washers will be unavailable.
- Score cards and pencils will be available upon request at the Pro Shop when checking in.
- Please remember to fix your divots on the greens.

## Other

- The driving range and practicing green will be open.
- The “Sunde Pavilion” will be open for golfers to use before and/or after their round.
  - A maximum of 4 people will be allowed at each picnic table.
- Garbage and recycling bins will be available at the front (red) tee boxes on each hole.
- League play and lessons may occur if all other criteria are met.
- Handshakes, high fives and hugging during or after your round is not permitted.

## Disciplinary Action

- We are fortunate to be playing the game that we all love, therefore, we have full confidence that everyone will respect and follow the rules/guidelines provided by the Government of Saskatchewan.
- Please help keep each other accountable for their actions to ensure a safe and fun golf experience for all.
- In the event that an individual is not following the rules/guidelines, the following “ 3 Incident Policy” may occur:
  - **1<sup>st</sup> Incident**
    - A phone call from a member of the Executive inquiring about the incident.
    - A discussion and first warning may be issued and documented.
  - **2<sup>nd</sup> Incident**
    - A written letter from a member of the Executive.
    - A 2 week suspension from all golf related activities.
  - **3<sup>rd</sup> & Final Incident**
    - A written letter from a member of the Executive.
    - An indefinite suspension of all golf related activities, with no refund.
- If you witness someone not following the rules/guidelines, please submit your formal complaint to [maplecreekgolfclub@gmail.com](mailto:maplecreekgolfclub@gmail.com), not to the Pro Shop employees. The Executive will investigate and follow up on any formal complaints received.

## Notes:

- If the Government of Saskatchewan orders golf courses to close, the executive will meet to decide what will happen with memberships and other related fees.
- If the Government of Saskatchewan changes any of the above rules and regulations, the executive will make adjustments to this document.
